

2017 Outdoor Adventure Camp Packing List

Please send old clothing with your child, as well as one pair of old shoes that can get muddy. Mark your child's belongings as we cannot be responsible for lost items. Lost and Found items are held at St. Christopher for two weeks following the end of the session and unclaimed items are then donated to charity.

As a Christian camp we want to promote modesty; therefore campers should only bring modest clothing. Your child should not bring inappropriate clothing to camp. This includes, but is not limited to: pajamas worn outside of cabins, halter tops, tube tops, shirts with spaghetti straps, boxer underwear worn as shorts, sports bras worn without a t-shirt, two piece bathing suits, cheerleader shorts rolled down, and clothing advertising alcohol or smoking. We recommend girls to wear shirts with sleeves, and require guys to wear a shirt at all times when they are not doing water activities. Staff will tell campers who are not appropriately dressed to change.

Please make sure that you label all items!

- Bible (NIV is preferred), pen, & note pad
- **Lightweight** sleeping bag (or sheets), and pillow
- Raincoat
- Laundry Bag / Plastic bag for wet and dirty clothes
- Labeled informal camp clothes (*please make sure that these are appropriate – see above*)
 - We highly suggest bringing some made from **non-cotton materials if you have them**
 - We will be getting really wet and occasionally muddy, so plan accordingly
- Clothes to sleep in
- 3 towels
- Toiletries
- One piece bathing suit
- One pair of old, lace-up shoes (*for the mud pit*)
- One other pair of lace-up shoes
- Water shoes or sandals with a back on them (not croc's)
- Hat/Cap
- Sunglasses
- Flashlight/headlamp
- **Sunscreen!**
- **Insect Repellent!**
- **At least two** 32 oz water bottles!

Optional

- Disposable Camera (*labeled with your name*)
- Cheap wristwatch
- Foam sleeping pad for additional comfort in bed!
- Notebook
- Pen, Paper, Stamps
- Books to read

What *not* to bring

No food, candy or beverages (other than water) are allowed in cabins. Knives, fireworks, weapons, drugs, alcohol, tobacco products and electronic cigarettes are banned. Students who are found with these will be sent home. Also, please leave boom boxes, beepers, cell phones, portable TV's, DVD players, CD players, video games, MP3 players (iPods etc.), pets, skateboards, inappropriate magazines or books, skim boards, surfboards, and expensive cameras/clothing/jewelry at home.
